## 2023 Capital Projects:

The board unanimously approved to proceed with the following projects:

- 2) Seal coating, repairing and striping of roads. Contract assigned to Kentucky Paving
- **3)** Caulking of front windows of upper units to prevent water leak to the unit below due to rain. Work assigned to Superior Contacting LLC

## **Community Items**

## **Garbage pickup streamlining update:**

- 1) all cans have been numbered with the appropriate unit number,
- 2) six new cans were requested and received,
- 3) Identified area near corrals with a sign where corral cans are to be placed for pickup,
- **4)** established direct communication with the new BRM commissioner responsible for sanitation to address garbage related issues and needs as they occur
- 5) discussed issues with the Republic truck driver during his run and his supervisor
- **6)** more effective and direct communication process was put in place amongst the driver, his supervisor, BRM, and DV to resolve issues in the moment as they occur.
- **7)** need to find out if separation of recycling items is still applicable. Currently the few cans used are mainly in corrals and used ,by choice, by multiple residents. If this is to continue we need to identify who will put them out for pickup and back in the corrals
- **8)** streamlining the process is ongoing and should be completed over the next few months, at which time, all residents will be asked to follow the process
- 9) the objective is to have a clean and problem-free garbage pickup for the betterment of our community where each member is responsible for their garbage disposal process

The Board agreed to conduct a ground walkthrough with Stout and Class A Lawn Care at our next meeting

The board agreed to have a community meeting around May/June. Date TBD
